

OUR STANDARD DRESS

2012 – 2013

General Guidelines

- A. All clothing worn by students **must** be purchased from Arthur's.
1. There are to be "NO" substitutions.
 2. For specific "standard dress" items including shirts/blouses/slacks/jumpers/skirts/sweaters & vests, please refer to the Arthur's order form; **copies are available at the school office.**
 3. Sizing: Please ensure you order a large enough size uniform. Tight clothing will not be permitted, and could require the purchase of additional clothing (if so determined by Administration).
 4. Sizing: All trousers/skirts are to be worn at the waistline. If oversize is purchased enabling trousers/skirts to be worn on the hips, the purchase of additional clothing will be required. Skirt length is to come below the knee when sitting.

B. All Students

1. For safety, all students will wear shoes. Unacceptable footwear for school and school activities include rubber, fabric or colored "flip-flops", high-top sneakers, high-heels and high platform shoes (greater than 1 ½ inches). Boys must wear socks at all times with shoes that are either black or brown in color and are fully laced and tied (no boots). **Note:** Athletic shoes/ gym shoes/sneakers are acceptable for elementary students (white soles preferred or a non-skid, non-marking shoe so as not to mark the gym floor).
2. Coats and heavy outerwear will not be worn in the classroom.
3. Outer apparel may be worn to school and utilized for outdoor related activities, but they may not be worn in the classrooms or chapel. All coats, jackets, hoodies, etc. must not have a worldly theme.
4. Only the "standard dress" cardigan sweater, sleeveless V-neck vest and/or V-neck pullover may be worn for additional warmth in the classroom or chapel, during the school day.
5. A T-shirt or other garment worn under the GBS shirt is not to be seen other than at the open collar area. A T-shirt or other garment worn under the GBS shirt is not to have lettering or be of such a color that can be seen through the GBS shirt. Only a white t-shirt without print or writing of any kind may be worn under a white oxford and a white polo shirt.

C. Girls

Blouses should fit neatly. Oxford shirts must be tucked in at all times. Only the collar button may be unbuttoned. Polo shirts may be worn out with only the collar button and the second button unbuttoned. For elementary girls, socks, tights or ankle-length leggings should be worn. Only sixth grade girls may wear nylons for regular school attire. Leggings are not acceptable for secondary girls. For secondary girls, nylons, tights, knee-high nylons or socks are to be worn throughout the school year with only exception being the warmer months: August-September, April-May. Sandals worn during these warmer months must be brown, black or white in color (see #1 above regarding "flip-flops". Secondary girls must wear a dress shoe or Docker/Sperry type shoe and should not wear lace-up tennis shoes of any kind (Converse, Keds, etc.). Extreme hairstyles, mod-type cuts, unnatural hair colors, hair extensions and/or feather

extensions are not allowed. Jewelry and make-up may be worn with moderation. Body piercing is limited to two holes and can only be in the ear lobe. Earrings are not to be larger than 1 inch below the bottom of the ear lobe. Tattoos will not be tolerated.

D. Boys

Shirts should fit neatly and be tucked in at all times. Oxford shirts may only have the collar button unbuttoned. The polo shirts may have the collar button and the second button unbuttoned. Slacks with belt loops must be worn with a belt. Socks are to be worn at all times. All boys must have conventional, traditional haircuts. “Mod”-type cuts or styles are not acceptable. Sideburns should be no lower than the middle of the ear. The hair must be tapered, not layered, and not touch the collar. Hair on the sides of the head must be tapered so that it does not touch the ear. Hair on the forehead must be above the eyebrows. Hair is not to be dyed, bleached or frosted. Young men are to be clean-shaven without mustaches. Jewelry (necklaces, earrings, bracelets), any type of body piercing and/or tattoos will not be tolerated.

E. School activities (includes athletic events): Regular school dress will be worn for all activities unless otherwise announced by the administration.

Standard Dress for Elementary Programs (Christmas/Fine Arts/Spring)

(Except when a specific theme is issued, i.e. “Western” etc.)

- A. Girls: K-4 thru 4th Grade—white long sleeve Peterpan blouse with navy polyester jumper
- B. Girls: 5th Grade—white long sleeve Peterpan blouse with navy polyester jumper or white long sleeve button-down Oxford with navy skirt
- C. Girls: 6th Grade—white long sleeve button-down Oxford with navy skirt
- D. Boys: K-4 thru 6th Grade—white long sleeve button-down Oxford with navy slacks

Standard Dress for Secondary Performing Groups

(7th–12th Grade: band/choir/ensembles)

- A. Girls: White long sleeve button-down Oxford, wine sleeveless V-neck vest, with khaki skirt.
- B. Boys: White long sleeve button-down Oxford with tie, wine V-neck long-sleeved pullover sweater, and khaki slacks.

Standard Dress for Athletic Teams

All students participating in the athletic program are required to wear knee-length athletic shorts for practices. For games, all participants are to be in full uniform or school standard dress as outlined above (if complete “warm-up” clothing is provided, that may be worn). The only acceptable footwear is athletic shoes, sneakers, or the shoes worn during the regular school day. If in uniform/warm-up clothing, an athletic slide type shoe is acceptable.
